B&B £25 Friendly, informal and whatever you're expectations of a B&B, this is a really great place to stay. Located on Llanberis High street. Organic or locally sourced produce used for cooking and packed lunches.

B&B from £35 ppn Reasonably good small hotel located in Capel Curig in the middle of the national Park. There's a public bar and pubs nearby. Evening meals and packed lunches available.

B&B single from £40 ppn twin sharing from £28 ppn A small hotel in Capel Curig with a good public bar. Above average bar meals with an extensive vegetarian and vegan menu. Packed lunches available.

B&B single from £50 ppn twin sharing from £45 ppn A comfortable small hotel if slightly overpriced. Public bar with evening meals. Within walking distance of the Bryn Tyrch and Cobdens.

B&B single from £30 ppn bunkhouse £11 ppn A small hotel on the outskirts of Llanberis with a lively public bar. Evening meals and packed lunches available.

Camping

There are number of campsites in the national park. The best is probably Eric Jone's campsite situated behind his cafe at the Tremadog cliffs . It's within walking distance of the pubs and places to eat at Tremadog village. However, this is only useful if we're climbing at Tremadog and you have your own transport. Another good site is at Nant Peris* (SH 607 584), 2 miles south east of Llanberis. It's opposite the Vaynol pub which does reasonable evening meals. Neither campsite requires pre booking.
